Question number 1 for 20 points. Statement and essence question. From the section titled "One Body, Many Parts."

2C 6:5 nights

Question number 3 for 30 points. Statement and quotation question. 4-part answer.

The word "sincerity" appears in 4 verses. Quote these verses.

1C 5:8 Therefore let us keep the Festival, not with the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with bread without yeast, the bread of sincerity and truth.

2C 1:12 Now this is our boast: Our conscience testifies that we have conducted ourselves in the world, and especially in our relations with you, in the holiness and sincerity that are from God. We have done so not according to worldly wisdom but according to God's grace.

2C 2:17 Unlike so many, we do not peddle the word of God for profit. On the contrary, in Christ we speak before God with sincerity, like men sent from God.

2C 8:8 I am not commanding you, but I want to test the sincerity of your love by comparing it with the earnestness of others.

Question number 4 for 20 points. Give a complete answer from 2 consecutive verses.

2C 11:32 In Damascus the governor under King Aretas had the city of the Damascenes guarded in order to arrest me.

2C 11:33 But I was lowered in a basket from a window in the wall and slipped through his hands.

1C 15:32 for tomorrow we die.
