1C 4:1 Christ

Question # 2 for 30 points. 3-part reference essence question. 4-part answer. From 1st Corinthians chapter 2 and 2nd Corinthians chapters 12 and 13.

Give in essence the verse that contains the phrase “**Spirit’s** power,” the 2 verses that contain the phrase “**God’s** power,” and the verse that contains the phrase “**Christ’s** power.”

1C 2:4 My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit’s power,

1C 2:5 so that your faith might not rest on men’s wisdom, but on God’s power.

2C 12:9 But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ’s power may rest on me.

2C 13:4 For to be sure, he was crucified in weakness, yet he lives by God’s power.

Likewise, we are weak in him, yet by God’s power we will live with him to serve you.

Question # 3 for 20 points. Give a complete answer from 2 consecutive verses. From the section titled “The Glory of the New Covenant.”
