Quote the verse that contains the 3-word phrase “**batch** without yeast” and the verse that contains the 3-word phrase “**bread** without yeast.”

1C 5:7 Get rid of the old yeast that you may be a new batch without yeast—as you really are. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.

1C 5:8 Therefore let us keep the festival, not with the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with bread without yeast, the bread of sincerity and truth.

Question # 2 for 30 points. Give a complete answer from 5 consecutive verses. From the section titled “Divisions in the Church.”

1C 1:13 Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Were you baptized into the name of Paul?

1C 1:14 I am thankful that I did not baptize any of you except Crispus and Gaius.

1C 1:15 so no one can say that you were baptized into my name.

1C 1:16 (Yes, I also baptized the household of Stephanas; beyond that, I don't remember if I baptized anyone else.)

1C 1:17 For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel—not with words of human wisdom, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.
