

Memorizing Tips

- Learn the name of the section title before you memorize it—you'll know what that section is basically about.
- Read PART of the verse out loud several times
- Quote (out loud) that part of the verse several times, always checking the scripture to make sure you don't miss a word.
- Read the rest or another part of the verse and do the same as above.
- Quote the whole verse several times, checking for errors.
- Move to the next verse.
- Quote 1 & 2.
- Learn 3.
- Quote 1-3, etc.
- On verse 6, work only on 6 through 10 and then quote 1-5 again then 6-10.
- Quote 1-10, etc.
- After you memorize that chapter or section, quote it to somebody.
- The next day, before you learn new material always re-quote the old material.
- When you quote, always say the name of the section title and the verses it covers before quoting. Ex.—“The Word Became Flesh” (1:1-1:18)
- Don't let the portion get dusty!

Learning References—After you've learned a chapter.

- Take the quote cards for one chapter.
- Divide them up into groups of ten (1-10, 11-20, 21-30, etc.)
- Mix them up and learn the first group of 10.
- After you've gotten all of them correct, move on to the next group.
- Combine 1-20—review 1-20
- Learn 21-30
- Do this until you've got the whole chapter learned.
