

# Understanding ?'s asked by References

## ACCORDING

--These questions are asked, "According to John X:Y, \_\_\_\_\_?"

The vs. reference will be followed by a question word—who, what, when, where, why  
(The Key Word **AFTER** the reference is where you will hit for a 10 pointer)  
(The Reference is where you will hit for a 20/30 pointer)

*(Be aware that these questions could be anything, so paying attention to the introductory remarks is vital—most of the time they will be labeled GCA)*

Example—According to John 1:15, what did John cry out?

## X:Y

These questions are asked, "John X:Y \_\_\_\_\_?"

If the Chapter is in the Intro. Remarks—From John Chapter X. The \_\_\_ verse...

*(These questions will ALWAYS ask for analysis; they will NEVER be labeled GCA)*

Example—John 1:6 names which individual? (John 1:6—John)

## HOW

--These questions are asked, "How does John X:Y describe \_\_\_\_\_?"

If Ch. is in the Intro. Remarks—From John Chapter X. How does the \_\_\_ verse...

*(Most of the time these will be labeled GCA)*

Example—How does John 1:6 describe John?

## IN

--These questions are asked, "In John X:Y, how does \_\_\_\_\_ address \_\_\_\_\_?"

When Chapter is in Intro. Remarks—From John Chapter X. In the \_\_\_ verse...

If someone is **specifically** addressed, then it will be, "In the \_\_\_ verse, who did \_\_\_ address?"

*(These questions will ALWAYS be worth 10 points; they will only require one to two word answers)*

Example—In John 1:49, how did Nathanael address Jesus? (John 1:49—Rabbi)
